Manitoba Back to Work Program	<ul> <li>Open to all Manitoba-based, private-sector and non-profit employers operating in Manitoba and meet following criteria:         <ul> <li>Possess active and valid Business Number, business bank account and email address;</li> <ul> <li>Registered and in good standing with Companies Office (not required for sole proprietors); and</li> <li>Has not received funding support from another government program for same position (not including the federal TWS)</li> </ul> </ul></li> </ul>	<ul> <li>50 percent of wage costs between July 16 and December 31, 2020, to a maximum of \$5,000 per worker</li> <li>Employers can hire 20 new or rehired employees under this program</li> <li>Employers that applied on or after November 10 will receive a lump sum upon submitting final claims</li> <li>Applications must have be submitted on or before December 1, 202</li> <li>Employers must provide proof of payment of wages and supporting payroll documentation February 1, 2021</li> <li>More details available: Back to Work MB Program</li> </ul>	9
