EVERYTHING COUNTS

The federal Scientific Research and Experimental Development (SR&ED) program encourages innovation with generous tax incentives for businesses. The program supports two distinct activities— Scientific Research and Research and Development (R&D). Many businesses do not realize their experimental development activities may be eligible for tax credits through this program. Is your business one of the many missing out on significant tax refunds?

The SR&ED Tax Incentive Program is available to Canadian businesses of all sizes and across all sectors that conduct scientific research or experimental development in order to develop new or improved products or processes.

With more than \$3 billion granted annually, the SR&ED program is the largest single source of federal and provincial government funding for business driven research and development. To take full advantage of these funding opportunities and the multitude of available provincial incentives, it is important you work with industry-leading professionals who have the knowledge and experience to ensure you get the most from the program.

WHAT ACTIVITIES QUALIFY?

A wide range of activities are eligible for SR&ED credits, including:

- Developing a new process or improving upon an existing process
- Creating new materials, devices and products or enhancing them by resolving technological challenges
- Basic or applied research

HOW MNP CAN ADD VALUE

The SR&ED program has become more stringent, requiring claimants to fulfill their obligations and fully support their claims. While claims can be filed 18 months after the fiscal year end, the sooner MNP is engaged in the process, the easier it becomes to structure compliant claims.



- **Reviewing your SR&ED Claims.** If you prefer to prepare your own claims, MNP will review your technical descriptions for their completeness and compliance with the program.

- **Training your Team.** MNP can provide your staff with valuable training and advice so they can identify eligible projects and produce the required documentation to support a claim.
- Supporting CRA Reviews. The Canada Revenue Agency occasionally reviews SR&ED claims. Your MNP advisor will be there to help prepare and support you throughout the review process. We also work closely with federal and provincial tax authorities to ensure both parties understand the process you used to conduct SR&ED. Through our in-depth knowledge of tax-related rules and regulations, we help you navigate the review process, foster understanding and help you avoid costly reassessments.
- **Strategic Tax Planning.** SR&ED tax credits can have a significant impact on your bottom line. That's why planning in advance is critical. To ensure you develop the optimal structure for your SR&ED claim, ask an MNP advisor to assist you with:

 - Establishing control systems and the required support
 - Reviewing your contracts for compliance

TAX SAVINGS POTENTIAL

SR&ED tax credits can have a measurable impact on your business' bottom line. While the combined federal and provincial tax credit rates differ based on certain criteria and the province you operate in, the potential savings are significant and can be as high as 70% of eligible R&D expenditure.

Funding issues don't have to keep you from conducting valuable research. The after-tax savings can open up SR&ED opportunities in the form of tax credits to help with cash flow through any stage of the R&D process.
